Everyone Should



Regularly and thoroughly clean their hands with an alcohol-based hand rub or soap



Follow good respiratory hygiene, wear mask and cover coughs & sneezes



Maintain at least 6 feet distance between themselves and others



Clean and disinfect frequently touched surfaces daily



Keep up to date on the latest information from trusted sources



Be alert for symptoms and monitor their health

COVIDSAFE can prevent workplace transmission by regular & repeated screening. It can assess the severity in order to identify individuals who may need early hospitalization and prioritizes them for a RT-PCR test.



Screening Tests

Blood Pressure, Glucose, Pulse Oximetry, BMI, etc

Stay safe at workplace with **COVIDSAFE**

As people of all ages can be infected by the new coronavirus, we advise everyone to take steps to protect themselves. However, based on risk score generated during your screening on HealthCube, we have additional recommendations:

Level 1

- You are safe to be in the work place
- Please continue to practice social distancing and frequent handwashing
- Wear a mask in public spaces
- Cover your mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing

Level 2

- You may have been exposed to someone who was positive for COVID-19
- You are recommended to go home
- Isolate yourself for 7 days or consult a doctor for a confirmatory COVID-19 test

Level 3

- Based on your screening results, you may need a COVID-19 specific test
- You are recommended to go home and isolate
- You will receive a call from the doctor to advise about your medical care and tests
